1. Guest speaker Jim Clarke presented an extensive review of the Alberta turkey management plan, Canadian turkey hunting opportunities, hunting tactics, and suggested equipment. There are over 22,000 people applying for Alberta Merriam turkey draws with only 150 tags issued per year. There are programs starting up to import and release turkeys in Alberta to encourage higher populations and more hunting opportunities.
